

## PUBLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

### *Nəşrə dair tələblər*

---

The journal "Mahmud Kashgarli" publishes articles on linguistics, literature, history, archeology, ethnography, etymology, culture and architecture of the Turkic peoples.

Articles (manuscripts) should be written and sent in one of Azerbaijani, Turkish, English or Russian languages to the journal's email address - mahmudkashgarli@gmail.com.

1. Articles should be typed in Microsoft Word Program, Times New Roman font - 12 pt., line spacing - 1.0 cm. Page sizes: right and left - 2.0 cm, top -2.5 cm, bottom -2, 2 cm.
2. The title of the article should be centered and written in bold and capital letters.
3. The structure of the article should consist of the following sections in the specified sequence: title of the article, author's name, patronymic, surname, scientific degree, academic title, ORCID code, email address, contact number and keywords (4-5 words), summary ( 150 - 200 words, 12 font), abstract, relevance, method, introduction, conclusion, bibliography.
4. Figures, pictures, illustrations, graphs and tables given in the article must be clear, correct, legible and given within the text, and the text relating to them should be written below.
5. The content of the summary, made in different languages, must be the same. For foreign authors, the annotation must be written in Turkish, English, Russian, but for local authors - in Azerbaijani, Russian and English.
6. Each summary should include the title of the article and the name of the author or co-authors. Depending on the nature of the scientific field, the articles should present conclusions, scientific novelty, practical significance, etc., made by the author or co-authors, and should be briefly reflected in the summary.
7. Footnotes should be indicated in parentheses inside the text and numbered in order of mentioning at the end of the article, indicating in parentheses of the text. For example (1,8 ).
8. Any reference information about each provided footnote must be complete and accurate. A bibliographic description of the cited source should be given depending on its type (monograph, textbook, scientific article, etc.). When referring to the materials of the symposium, conference or thesis, the title of the article should be indicated.
9. The volume of the article should not exceed 12 pages, within at least 7 - 8 pages.
10. Articles are published on the basis of an expert opinion (confidentially) by decision of the editorial board of the journal. The editors reserve the right to return the article to the author for correction.
11. The author is personally responsible for scientific novelty, abstracts, any materials presented in the article.
12. Articles not published in the journal are not returned.
13. Articles sent from abroad are published free of charge.
